## Vintage Crochet Motif #2: A Motif from Mom



A Note about this Motif: I have recreated this motif from one I found tucked away in a ball of crochet thread from my Mom's stash. The motif is the one she used to crochet me a tablecloth.

Supplies: Size 10 Crochet Thread

Crochet Hook Size US 7 (1.50 mm)

3 TC Cluster: Cluster made with 3 TC 4 TC Cluster: Cluster made with 4 TC

Chain 8 and join with sl st.

Rd 1: [Ch 4 (counts as 1<sup>st</sup> TC), then 2 TC to make 3 TC Cluster], Ch 5, [3 TC Cluster, Ch5] 7 times. (Total of 8 3TC Clusters) SI st to top of 1<sup>st</sup> 3TC Cluster.

Rd 2:[SC in 3TC Cluster, SC in each Ch st] 8 times. SI st to 1<sup>st</sup> SC.

Rd 3: Ch 5, \*[SC in 3<sup>rd</sup> SC, Ch 5, SC in 3TC Cluster, Ch 5], repeat around. Sl st to join.

Rd 4: [Ch 4, 7 TC in 1<sup>st</sup> Ch Sp (counts as 8 TC)], Ch 3, SC in next Ch Sp, Ch 3, [8 TC in next Ch Sp, Ch 3, SC in next Ch Sp, Ch 3] 7 times. Sl st to Ch 4 to join.

Rd 5: [Ch 4, TC in next 7 TC], Ch 1, TC in SC, Ch 1, TC in next 8 TC, Ch 3, TC in SC, Ch 5, TC in same SC, Ch 3, [TC in next 8 TC, Ch 1, TC in SC, Ch 1, TC in next 8 TC, Ch 3, TC in SC, Ch 5, TC in same SC, Ch 3] 3 times. SI st to Ch 4.



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


Rd. 6: SI st in  $1^{st}$  TC, Ch 4, TC in next 5 TC, Ch 3, SC in next TC, Ch 3, Skip  $1^{st}$  TC, TC in next 6 TC, Ch 3, TC in  $2^{nd}$  Ch Sp, Ch 5, TC in same Ch Sp, Ch 3, [Skip  $1^{st}$  TC, TC in next 6 TC, Ch 3, SC in next TC, Ch 3, Skip  $1^{st}$  TC, TC in next 6 TC, Ch 3, TC in  $2^{nd}$  Ch Sp, Ch 5, TC in same Ch Sp, Ch 3] 3 times. SI st to Ch 4 to join.

Rd 7: SI st in 1<sup>st</sup> TC, TC in next 4 TC, Ch 3, SC in 1<sup>st</sup> Ch Sp, Ch 5, SC in next Ch Sp, Ch 3, Skip 1<sup>st</sup> TC, TC in next 4 TC, Ch 3, TC in 2<sup>nd</sup> Ch Sp, Ch 3, TC in same Ch Sp, Ch 5, TC in same Ch Sp, Ch 3, TC in same Ch Sp, Ch 3, [Skip 1<sup>st</sup> TC, TC in next 4 TC, Ch 3, SC in 1<sup>st</sup> Ch Sp, Ch 5, SC in next Ch Sp, Ch 3, Skip 1<sup>st</sup> TC, TC in next 4 TC, Ch 3, TC in same Ch Sp, Ch 3, TC in same Ch Sp, Ch 3, TC in same Ch Sp, Ch 3] 3 times. SI St to Ch 4.

Rd 8: [4TC Cluster, Ch 5, TC in 1<sup>st</sup> Ch Sp, Ch 5, TC in next Ch Sp, Ch 5, TC in next Ch Sp, Ch 5, 4 TC Cluster, Ch 5, TC in next TC, Ch 5, TC in next TC, Ch 5, 3 TC Cluster in Ch Sp, Ch 5, 3 TC Cluster in same Ch Sp, Ch 5, TC in next TC, Ch 5, TC in next TC, Ch 5] 4 times. Sl st to Ch 4 and fasten off.

## Instructions for Clusters:



3 TC Cluster: This is a cluster made with 3 TC as follows: Make 3 TC, leaving the last loop of each stitch on the hook, then join by pulling thread through all loops together.

4 TC Cluster: This cluster is made as for the 3 TC Cluster, but with 4 TC

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
